Qualifications:

- Successful applicants must be currently licensed at the A-EMT level or higher in the State of Wisconsin.
- Current American Heart Association or equivalent BLS for Healthcare provider CPR card
- Must have a State issued current Driver's License and Clean Driving Record
- Must pass a health caregiver background
- Must have at least 1 year's previous ambulance experience
- High School diploma or equivalent (GED)

Requirements

- Must successfully complete IV and medication training through Gordon-Wascott EMS
- Must understand the protocols and procedures of Gordon-Wascott EMS
- Demonstrated ability to organize, problem solve, make decisions during emergency situation and work independently
- Provides compassionate basic life support care to patients of all ages at the scene and in the ambulance
- Protects patient and team member privacy and only accesses patient and / or team member related information as needed to perform job duties
- Communicates patient outcomes verbally with accurate concise rado reports to the accepting hospital and to hospital staff accepting patient
- completes accurate written customer care record that is legible at completion of customer transport and enters completed per established policies and procedures
- stocks /restocks equipment and supplies used and reports deficiencies
- cleans equipment and vehicle thoroughly
- Accepts other duties as assigned to promote the accomplishment of organizational goals
- Team member is accountable to maintain skill proficiency, including improvement where deemed necessary, and upgrading additional or new skills on the appropriate skills listed
