Providing ambulance service to the residents and visitors of Gordon and Wascott since 1958. Staffed by nationally registered and state licensed Emergency Medical Technicians with the support of skilled Emergency Medical Responder (1st responders). Working in cooperation with all area hospitals and advanced life support helicopter services to provide AFFORDABLE emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

There are two fully equipped ambulances in service 24- hours/day, 7-days/week, 365-days/year. Each ambulance is equipped with an Automatic Defibrillator Unit. Both units are ready for emergency and non-emergency transport and medical care.

Thank you to the board members, the community, the members of the fire departments (Gordon and Wascott) and all members of the service.

2018 Year run totals: 168 runs from Medicals to Fire standby, 84 Gordon, 55 Wascott and 29 were mutual aid to our surrounding communities.

Accomplishments for 2018:

- Added and trained on equipment and skills through grants and donations
 - Alice Trained , Street Smarts for EMS, Simulator Driving and patient care
- Added 3 new members
- Some members hit milestones for the service from 1000 runs to 15 yrs on the service. If you see any of our EMS members please thank them for the hard work and dedication they have to the service and communities.

2019 plan is to:

- Training that will keep us up-to-date in the forever evolving treatment of our patient's.
- Update equipment :
 - Radio battery's
 - Cot battery's
 - 2 back boards with straps
 - Jump bags
 - Sauger splint – for splinting long bone fractures in the legs
 - 2 cot quilts
- Here is our long range plan:
 - Update our septic system Spring 2019
 - Incentives/Recruitment for members
 - Monitors x2 one for each Ambulance, these monitors will need to be replaced by 2020,
 - Ambulance replaced by 2025
