Tournament will be held at the Ballpark in Gordon, WI off of Antoine Circle on Sunday, July 2, 2023 @ 12 Noon

Sunday, July 2, 2023: Registration 11:30am; Tournament begins at Noon. Proceeds benefit GGND Fireworks.

SCORING

- ★ Each bag on the box = 1 point
- ★ Each bag in the hole = 3 points
- ★ Any bags touching the ground or “bounced” onto the box do not count and are to be removed prior to the next bag being thrown by the opposing team.
- ★ Total points for each team are calculated using only those points that were not canceled out.

Example:

- Team 1 throws 1 bag in the hole and 3 bags land on the box for a total of 6 points;
- Team 2 throws 1 bag in the hole and 2 bags land on the box for a total of 5 points;
- Then Team 1 receives 1 point for that round.

- ★ The 1st team to score 21 points or more will be declared the winner. A tie will require extra innings until a winner is decided. (No whitewashes permitted at all; all games go to 21 or more to win)
- ★ The tournament is double elimination; the winning team will move onto the next round; winner’s bracket and the opposing team will move onto the loser’s bracket. Losing teams from loser’s bracket are eliminated from the game.

All entries will be processed in order of receipt and are subject to availability.

GGND Team Cornhole Fun Tournament – Rules and Regulations

1. Each team has 5 minutes to report to course when called. Failure to report in that time will forfeit the match.
2. This is a family-friendly event. Please refrain from inappropriate language and observe the rules of good sportsmanship at all times.
3. First team to 21 points (meeting or exceeding) wins. For the first round of play, teams will be picked from a hat and placed onto the corresponding bracket line until all teams have been matched up
4. Cancellation scoring will be used.
5. 3 points will be scored for a bag in the hole. 1 point will be scored for a bag on the board.
6. A coin toss will take place prior to start of the contest. The winner of the coin toss has the option EITHER to throw first or to choose to which side their team will throw from.
7. Team member substitution not permitted once the tournament has started
8. The first side of players alternate pitching corn bags until they have thrown all 4 bags, then the remaining players (pitching from the other cornhole platform) continue to alternate in the same manner.
9. Contestants not pitching shall not make distracting sounds or movements while opponents are pitching.
10. The pitcher must remain behind the front of the board during the entire address and release of the corn bag.
11. Any corn bag that leaves a contestant's hand once the final forward swing of the delivery process has started shall count as a pitched corn bag. A corn bag that is accidentally dropped by a contestant before the final forward swing has started shall not be considered foul and may be picked up and pitched.
12. A contestant's corn bags shall be called foul if the contestant removes bags before scoring of the corn bag has been agreed upon. Tournament staff shall be called if a decision cannot be reached. The staff shall determine the scoring for that inning.
13. Any corn bag that contacted the ground before coming to rest on the board or is touching the ground in any way shall be called foul and removed from the board.
